## **ESSAY GUIDELINES**

1. Students will write an original and creative essay of no more than 1000 words that demonstrate an understanding of Amelia Earhart and the impact of her contributions to aviation and women's rights and Zonta International.
2. Students should use a variety of sources and cite a minimum of three sources in the completed essay.
3. Format: Type essay in English, free from errors in spelling, punctuation and grammatical usage. Use Arial or Times New Roman font, 12-point. Use 1-inch margins at the top and bottom, left and right. Place essay title on the first page, top center.
4. E-mail entries to: [lpierce@windstream.net](mailto:lpierce@windstream.net).
5. Complete the entry form cover sheet. This is the *only* page where the entrant's name will be placed.

### **When is the deadline?**

Completed essay application entries are due to the school counselor's office **no later than Friday January 11, 2019, Zonta's Amelia Earhart Day.**

### **When is the winner announced?**

The essay contest winner will be announced on Friday, January 18, 2019. Schools will be notified.
