

Woodland Elementary School UNIFORM POLICY 2011-2012

Students at Woodland Elementary will continue to wear uniforms.

1. Uniform dress code begins the first day of the school year.
2. Uniform will consist of:
 - Pants - solid navy or tan pants, Capri pants, shorts, skirts, or jumpers. Length of shorts, skirts, and jumpers must be NO shorter than 4 inches above the knee.
 - Shirts - solid light blue, (**NOT** aqua) royal blue, white, or navy button down blouse with a collar or polo shirt with a collar. Turtlenecks are also acceptable. Shirts are to have sleeves. Solid colored sweaters, sweatshirts (without hood), and sweater vests are optional but need to be navy, royal blue, white, light blue and must be worn over collared shirt. Shirts worn under the uniform shirt is to be uniform color.
 - Belts, without decorative buckles, need to be worn if there are belt loops. Belt loops should not be removed from pants. **FIRST AND SECOND GRADE STUDENTS ARE EXCLUDED FROM WEARING A BELT UNLESS PARENTS CHOOSE DIFFERENTLY.**
3. All shirts must be tucked in, in such a way that the belt may be seen.
4. Socks need to be worn and visible. Tights may also be worn. (This includes when a student wears sandals.) They should be solid and uniform color.
5. Tennis shoes are highly recommended and may be required for students who are not prepared for physical education classes on more than 3 occasions due to lack of proper shoes. Shoestrings should be tied and shoes should be tied in such a manner that the shoes are not lose. Sandals must have a strap around the heel. No flip-flops, jellies, crocs, mule shoes, or similar shoes will be permitted. Shoes should be usable and safe for physical activity.
6. All uniform attire should properly fit the student.
 - No sagging pants, shorts, etc. will be allowed.
 - No biker pants/shorts (Spandex), stretch, sweat, or jogging pants are to be worn.
 - No oversized clothing. (This includes length of sweatshirts.)
7. Students not in compliance with the uniform dress guidelines will Immediately upon arrival:
 - Call home and request uniform attire be brought to school.
 - If not resolved, uniform will be provided for the school day by the Family Resource Center. (Please return uniform the following day.)
 - Letter will be sent home to parents.
 - ****Upon the third occurrence of a violation of the uniform dress code, a student will automatically be assigned detention. Violations include: wearing no belt, wearing any item or color not allowed by policy, and consistently wearing shirt not tucked in after being reminded to do so. Teachers are to be consistent in strictly enforcing this policy. ****
8. Transfer students will have two weeks to be in compliance with the uniform guidelines.
9. The Woodland Family Resource Center will work with families unable to supply a uniform through local resources.
10. Students are to adhere to the Hardin County Code of Conduct regarding proper appearance.
11. Spirit Days will be designated throughout the school year and students will earn the privilege to participate in school spirit days.
12. Hair color or style should not be a distraction to classroom instruction.
