The Radcliff Rotary Club is offering a \$4,000 scholarship this year to a graduating senior who will continue his/her education at a college or university. We will provide two such scholarships: one to a senior from both Fort Knox and North Hardin High Schools. If you are interested in applying for the scholarship, please complete the application form and return it with attachments to your guidance counselor no later than Tuesday, April 30th.

The following criteria will be considered for award of the Radcliff Rotary Scholarship:

1. The candidate must be a graduating senior from North Hardin or Fort Knox High School.
2. The candidate will be required to enroll as a full time student at a two-year or four-year college or university.
3. The candidate shall be responsible for the completion and return by April 30th of required forms:
 - a. Application for scholarship.
 - b. Essay explaining why scholarship is needed.
4. The final award will be based on
 - a. Academics 30%
 - b. School & Community activities 30%
 - c. Essay 40%
5. Checks will be made out to the awardees school of choice.
